## Postponement repayment for companies

Total companies within reach of measure **175,000**  
Received postponements **99,000**

## SME Credit Guarantee Scheme (BMKB-C)

Loans granted to companies **800-1,000**  
Total financing provided **250-350 million euros**  
Expected to rise with **several thousand** in the coming weeks

Week 10 (March 2) **104,814,000**  
Week 14 (March 30) **80,926,000**

Since the limit for contactless pay **without PIN** increased to **50 euros**, people make more contactless payments

Cash withdrawals  
Week 10 (March 2) approx. **4 million**  
Week 14 (March 30) approx. **2.2 million**
